What we Collect

We may collect the following information:

- Name and job title
- Contact information including email address
- Demographic information such as postcode, preferences and interests, other information relevant to customer surveys and/or offers.

How we collect your personal data

We may collect your personal data when you contact us through our website, by telephone, post, email or through any other means.

Sensitive personal data

How we use personal data

We will use the information held about you for the purposes for which it was provided to us as stated at the point of collection (or as may be obvious in the context of collection). Your personal data will be used by us in the following ways:

Security

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

Your data protection rights

How we use Cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual.
